Q1	In the election this year you will be able to vote on Proposal 1, which deals with legislative term -limits and financial disclosure. The Amendment would change the term limits for state legislators from three 2-year terms in the state House and two 4-year terms in the state Senate to 12 combined years in the Legislature, and provide that elected state legislative and state executive officials must file annual financial disclosure reports on their income, assets, liabilities, gifts from lobbyists, positions held in certain organizations, and agreements on future employment. Q2 You'll also be able to vote on Proposal 2, which deals with voting laws. The Amendment would create a nine-day early voting period; allow voters to present photo identification or sign an affidavit when voting in person or applying for an absentee ballot; require that military and overseas ballots postmarked by election day are counted; provide voters with a right to request an absentee ballot; and require the state to fund a number of absentee ballot dropboxes, among other provisions.
